



## **Board Policy 408: Responsible Use of Computing Resources**

### **Personnel**

A computing resource is any hardware, software, or data used in computing, processing, storing, or transmitting information. Iowa Valley Community College District provides these resources in order for the District to achieve its mission and conduct day-to-day operations. All users, including faculty, staff, students, and other authorized users, are to only use these computing resources for academic and college-related business functions.

The use of the District's computing resources is a privilege and not a right. All users are responsible for the integrity of these resources. They are not to be used in any way that may be disruptive, offensive, or illegal. The District reserves the right to extend, limit, restrict, or deny access to computing resources. Users found in violation of this policy will be subject to discipline, including but not limited to, sanctions as outlined in the accompanying guideline.
