



Board Policy 500: Student Conduct and Expectations

Students

The Board of Directors is committed to protecting the rights of individual students while promoting the safety and welfare of the entire District community. The Board expects students to follow all applicable laws, regulations, and District student conduct rules. The Board authorizes the President and/or designees to establish and enforce academic and non-academic rules of student conduct. These rules will include procedures for investigating and adjudicating disciplinary complaints and will include the establishment of sanctions.

The Student Code of Conduct rules and procedures are made available to students through the IVCCD Student Handbook and College Catalog. Students are responsible for being familiar with the information contained in the handbook and catalog, including any changes to rules or procedures made by the District and communicated to students. The Board of Directors will approve the additions to the handbook and catalog as needed to provide fair procedures for discipline, and the protection of individual rights while providing for a safe educational environment.
